Our 2011 – 2012 Awana year is almost here!! Our first night of club will be Friday, September 9th. Enclosed you will find registration forms for each of your children. If you need more registration forms, you may pick them up on Sunday after the Morning Worship Service (worship ends approximately 12:15). Awana leaders will also be available to answer questions or pick up forms at the church office between 9a.m. and 1p.m. Monday through Friday.

Our registration fee this year to \$30.00 for each child **however**; we offer an *early registration discount!* If you fill out the enclosed registration forms and the forms are received at Vintage Park Community Church before 6:30p.m. September 9th, the registration fee will be \$25.00 per child. (A check for \$25.00 per child needs to be included with registration forms to appreciate the discount.) A few things to remember:

Club **begins at 6:30p.m. and ends at 8:30p.m.** Please arrive promptly! The playground will be open at 6:15p.m. Please stay with your child and help sign them into their club between 6:25p.m. and 6:30p.m. Please return at 8:15p.m. for the award ceremony that takes place each night in your child's club. All Cubbies (pre-school) and Sparks (K–2nd grades) and T&T (grades 3rd – 6th) need to be signed in and out by an adult. This is for the protection of your child.

Please have your children wear sneakers that fit properly (no slide-in, heel-less, platform or hee-lies) as we play games on the blacktop outside. This is to protect your child from getting hurt during games. Children who do not have sneakers on may be asked to sit out at game time.

As the weather gets cool, please send your child with a jacket as we will continue to play games outside as long as it is not raining and not too cold.
